STEP 1 Attach TV Plate to TV

1-1 Choose correct configuration per your TV VESA size (hole pattern on TV back)


If your TV VESA size is above 200*200mm, you need to assemble extended arms **12** onto plate **13** using bolts **14** and Alley key **13** per below option 3 - option 6 shown.


1-4 Attach the TV Plate onto TV back Using Correct Bolts and Spacers


















STEP 2 Column Installation

Assemble the column 06 on the glass base 05 through iron sheet 08 and plastic sleeve 07 with screw 12.





STEP 3 Hang and Secure Pre-assembled TV Unit onto the Column

Pretighten the screws 09 as the TV height you desired, and hang your TV unit on the screws 09 by fastening the screws and washers ... 09 03

STEP 4 Adjustments

4-1 TV Tilting up adjustment (+3°): If you need to tilt TV, you can loosen the bolts below and tilt up +3° Then tighten the bolts.





4-2 Height Adjustment If the TV height is still not suitable, you can adjust the height by following the steps below.
