



PORG CROCHET PATTERN

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WISH YOU A PLEASANT CROCHETING TIME

Materials:

To make you will need

- Cotton yarn YarnArt Jeans (50g/160m) (or another yarn that matches the density):
 - for brown porg: cocoa (71), white (62), beige (07), light beige (87)
 - for black porg: black (28), white (62), beige (07)
- Plastic eyes with safety backing 12 mm
- Polyester fiberfill for stuffing
- Sewing yarn needle
- Crochet hooks size 2mm
- black thread for mouth embroidery

Abbreviations:

sc single crochet

inc increase

dec decrease

sl st slip stitch

ch chain stitch

rnd(s) round(s)

()*... = repeat the instruction in brackets N times

(...) = the total amount of loops in the row



Wings: make 2

Crochet in rounds. Colour 71(cocoa):

1. 6 sc in a magic ring (6 sc)
2. (sc, inc)*3 (9 sc)
3. 9 sc
4. (2 sc, inc)*3 (12 sc)
5. (3 sc, inc)*3 (15 sc)
- 6.-9. 15 sc (4 rounds)
10. (3 sc, dec)*3 (12 sc)
11. 12 sc

Fold the wings and crochet them together with dec, 2 sc, dec. Cut the yarn and leave a long thread to sew onto the body later.

Legs: make 2

Crochet in rounds. Colour 07(beige):

1. 6 sc in a magic ring (6 sc)
2. inc*6 (12 sc)
- 3.-5. 12 sc (3 rounds)
6. (dec, 4 sc)*2 (10 sc)
7. 10 sc
8. (dec, 3 sc)*2 (8 sc)
9. 8 sc
10. dec*4 (4 sc)

Finish with sl st and close the hole with a tapestry needle.



Body :

Crochet in rounds. Color 71(cocoa):

1. 6 sc in a magic ring (6 sc)
2. inc*6 (12 sc)
3. (inc*3, 3 sc)*2 (18 sc)
4. ((sc, inc)*3, 3 sc)*2 (24 sc)
5. (2 sc, inc)*2, **color change into light beige: 2 sc, inc, sc, color change into cocoa: 2sc, color change into light beige: 2sc, inc, sc, color change into cacao: sc, inc, 2sc, inc, 3sc** (30sc)
6. 8 sc, **color change into light beige: 12 sc, color change cocoa: 10 sc** (30 sc)

7. (3 sc, inc)*2, **color change into light beige: 3 sc, inc, color change into white: 4 sc, color change into light beige: 2 sc, inc, sc, color change into cocoa: 2 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 3sc** (36 sc)
8. 9 sc, **5 sc**, 6 sc, **5 sc**, 11 sc (36 sc)
9. 10 sc, **5 sc**, 5 sc, **5 sc**, 11 sc (36 sc)
10. 12 sc, 11 sc, 13 sc (36 sc)
11. 14 sc, 3 sc, (3 sc in 1 ch)*2, 3 sc, 14 sc (40 sc)
12. 14 sc, 12 sc, 14 sc (40 sc)
13. 13 sc, 3 sc, dec*4, 4 sc, 12 sc (36 sc)
14. 13 sc, 11 sc, 12 sc (36 sc)
15. (5 sc, inc)*2, sc, 4 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, (5 sc, inc)*2 (42 sc)
16. 15 sc, 13 sc, 14 sc (42 sc)
17. 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 4 sc, 2 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 3 sc, 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 3 sc (48 sc)
- 18.-19. 17 sc, 16 sc, 15 sc (2 rounds)
- 20.-21. 18 sc, 15 sc, 15 sc (2 rounds)
- || Attach the safety eyes between rd 8 and 9, spacing them by 6 to 7 visible stitches.||**
22. (dec, 6 sc)*2, dec, sc, 5 sc, dec, 6 sc, (dec, 6 sc)*2 (42 sc)
23. 16 sc, 12 sc, 14 sc (42 sc)
24. (dec, 5 sc)*2, dec, sc, 4 sc, dec, 5sc, (dec, 5 sc)*2 (36 sc)
25. 2 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 2 sc, 2 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 2 sc (30 sc)
- Start to fill the body with fiberfill until rd 25.**
26. (dec, 3 sc)*2, dec, sc, 2 sc, dec, 3 sc, (dec, 3 sc)*2 (24 sc)
27. (2 sc, dec)*6 (18 sc)
28. (dec, sc)*6 (12)
29. dec*6
- Fasten the thread and cut.**



Embroider the eyelids as shown in the photo. Sew on the eyelids with sewing thread for extra reinforcement (several stitches):



Assembling

Sew the legs carefully to the body.



Sew the wings to the body between rd 12 and 13



embroider mouth:
